


Your library depends upon its communication with the community to convey information, create engagement and foster a lifelong relationship.

Creating and maintaining a consistent digital and print visual message can be difficult when responsibilities and tasks are spread among departments or individuals.

NEO-RLS Visual Identity Assessment helps ensure that your graphic message is consistent by providing a comprehensive assessment of your library's print and digital communication, and making recommendations as needed to strengthen and unify your visual messaging.

The NEO-RLS Visual Identity Assessment:

- Provides a detailed audit of your visual communication and brand, noting clear areas of strength and advising on methods to reduce visual fragmentation
- Outlines a clear and consistent graphic communication strategy with specific guidelines for typography, color usage, image sizing and more
- Can be implemented immediately by all staff using the visual design software with which they are comfortable

Visual Identity Assessment Cost

NEO-RLS charges an hourly fee for consulting. The total cost is based on the number of hours involved and the level of library membership.

2017-2018 (begins July 1, 2017) charges are as follows: \$100.00 per hour for Gold Member libraries. Gold Members receive a total of four (4) hours of free consulting which may be applied to any consulting costs. The hourly cost for Silver Member libraries is \$125.00 per hour, \$150.00 per hour for Bronze Member libraries and \$200.00 per hour for Geographic Member libraries.
