

STAFF DAY PLANNING



Great libraries are only as great as their staff

and a skilled, highly motivated staff is only possible through continuous development and team-building. Making staff training and development a priority takes a lot of time and planning. The Northeast Ohio Regional Library System offers Staff Day planning for a single library, for multiple libraries or for all of the libraries in a county or specified area. Let us help you invest in your staff by taking the worry and stress out of Staff Day.

NEO-RLS's Staff Day planning:

- Provides training with a focus specific to your library and staff needs
- Enables participation from all staff at one time
- Works to bring staff together
- Promotes opportunity for staff recognition

- Utilizes NEO-RLS ability to negotiate costs

Staff Day Planning Services	
Initial Meeting with Library: NEO-RLS will meet with designated representatives of the library to define expectations for the day including types and topics of training, number of programs, number of staff attending, schedule for the day and budget.	5* Hours
Secure Venue: NEO-RLS will locate appropriate venue if desired and arrange for designated library representatives to view venue. Once decision is made, the venue will be secured and NEO-RLS will negotiate costs and terms. The venue is paid separately by the library.	6* Hours
Locate Appropriate Speakers: NEO-RLS will locate appropriate speakers based on training topics and budget. NEO-RLS will negotiate costs and terms.	4* Hours
Create Speaker Agreements: NEO-RLS will create all speaker agreements, including 1099 forms and other paperwork.	2* Hours
Preparation of Materials (Optional): NEO-RLS will prepare all materials including agendas and training hand-outs as requested.	5-10* Hours
On-Site Facilitation: NEO-RLS will facilitate Staff Day on-site in order to make certain that all runs smoothly. On-site facilitation allows everyone to participate in Staff Day without worry.	10* Hours

Staff Day Planning Cost

NEO-RLS charges an hourly consulting fee for Staff Day planning. The total cost is based on the number of hours involved and the level of library membership.

2016-2017 (ends June 30, 2017) charges are as follows: \$250.00 per hour with a 75% discount provided to Gold Member libraries; a 60% discount provided to Silver Member libraries; a 40% discount provided to Bronze Member libraries. Geographic Member libraries are charged the straight hourly fee.

2017-2018 (begins July 1, 2017) charges are as follows: \$100.00 per hour for Gold Member libraries with 4 hours FREE; \$125.00 per hour for Silver Member libraries; \$150.00 per hour for Bronze Member libraries; \$200.00 per hour for Geographic Member libraries.

Libraries pay venue directly. All other costs and NEO-RLS services are paid with one check to NEO-RLS.

Melissa Lattanzi B.S., has been employed for 22 years with NEO-RLS and has considerable experience with event planning and a vast knowledge of public libraries and their continuing education interests.
